## EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION REGISTRATION

*June 1<sup>st</sup> Hurricane Season Begins*

**CBCAN** is the **Coastal Bend Coordination and Alert Network**. Ingleside participates in CBCAN and as a resident of Ingleside you can sign up to receive notifications in the event of an emergency or any other notifications the City sends out. Registration is easy and one of the best actions that you can take to prepare yourself and your family for emergencies and disasters. To sign up, simply go to the City's website at [www.inglesidtx.gov](http://www.inglesidtx.gov) and look under "Read all News" or go to the Emergency Preparedness page and click on the link for Coastal Bend Coordination and Alert Network and you'll be taken to the CBCAN Resident Registration page. Click the boxes under **San Patricio County** for National Weather Service Notifications and City of Ingleside Notifications and then click the New i-Info Registration button at the bottom of the page. Fill in your contact information and you'll be able to customize what kind of Alerts you receive!

## BRUSH COLLECTION ROUTES AND SCHEDULES

The City is divided into two (2) sectors with four (4) sections in each sector with each section having brush pickup for one week in an eight (8) week rotation period. Sector A will be picked up in odd months and Sector B will be picked up in even months. The week of pick up will correspond with the section number.

### **Sector A**

Section 1A: 1<sup>st</sup> week of month  
Section 2A: 2<sup>nd</sup> week of month  
Section 3A: 3<sup>rd</sup> week of month  
Section 4A: 4<sup>th</sup> week of month

### **Sector B**

Section 1B: 1<sup>st</sup> week of month  
Section 2B: 2<sup>nd</sup> week of month  
Section 3B: 3<sup>rd</sup> week of month  
Section 4B: 4<sup>th</sup> week of month

### **Sector A months:**

**January, March,  
May, July,  
September,  
November**

### **Sector B months:**

**February, April,  
June, August,  
October, December**

**Sec. 30-92. - Depositing garbage, trash and rubbish on public or private property.**

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to have an accumulation of green waste on improved residential and/or multifamily property **more than 30 days prior to the city's scheduled pick-up** for that area. The city's schedule of regular pick-ups is located at city hall and public works offices.
