

CITY OF INGLESIDE, TEXAS  
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS  
FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The City of Ingleside will design and construct projects assisted by the TWDB Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, Clean Water State Revolving Fund programs of the Texas Water Development Board, Water Development Fund of the Texas Water Development Board to design and construct a new 2.0 mgd Wastewater Treatment Facility. Accordingly, the City of Ingleside is seeking to contract with:

1. A qualified professional engineer or professional engineer consulting firm to provide engineering and environmental information for any application for financial assistance; develop a preliminary engineering report detailing the wastewater treatment facility; develop a final engineering report detailing the wastewater treatment facility; provide as needed services during consideration of the City's application by the Texas Water Development Board;
2. A qualified financial advisor or financial advisor firm to provide advice and professional recommendations for: strategic financial planning; analysis of market conditions; recommended investments of bond proceeds; and provide recommendation to the City for any financing or capital projects or refinancing of current debt that may be necessary. The prepare all preliminary and final financial applications to the Texas Water Development board and/or United States Department of Agriculture; and
3. A qualified Bond Counsel firm to provide objective legal opinion with respect to assessing the viability of authorizing and issuing evidences of indebtedness and of executing contractual grant agreements to the Texas Water Development Board.

Please submit your proposal of services and a statement of qualification for these proposed series to the City of Ingleside, City Manger, at 2671 San Angelo, Ingleside, Texas, 78362. Proposals must be received no later than 3:00 p.m., Monday, June 26, 2017 to be considered. No electronic submission will be accepted.
