Fire Marshal

When was the last time you tested your smoke alarms?

Last month? Last year? Can't remember? If you're not sure your smoke alarms are working, then how can you be sure you'll be protected if a fire breaks out? Don't gamble with your life and assume your smoke alarms are working. Test each one, every month, so you'll know they'll be ready to protect you and your family if there's a fire. Test your alarm for life.

"Get Out, Stay Out" - Your fire safe response

What would you do if your home caught on fire? Would you know where to go if smoke or flames blocked your escape? There is no time to think about these questions in a real fire. It's hot, smoky, and so dark you may not be able to see your own hands. Know ahead of time what to do if there's a fire. Develop an escape plan with two ways out of every room. You'll need a second way in case your primary exit is blocked by smoke or flames. And make sure every exit is accessible, including windows. Getting out is your first priority in a fire. And once out, stay out!

Building: Code Enforcement

In Ingleside we enjoy a curb side bulk pick up service every Friday as well as brush pick up every 2 months. There are some rules to follow when using this service and we need the help of all residents so there is no interruption in removal of these items in a timely manner.

Bulk trash items must be kept separate from brush or neither one will get picked up. Please be aware that you MUST call (361) 776-2517 by Thursday before 5 pm in order to schedule a bulk pick up at your address on Friday or else it will not be picked up.

There are restrictions on what can be removed under the bulk pick up service. Tires, chemicals of any kind and construction debris are just a few of the items NOT allowed for removal. Please check our website at: <http://inglesidetx.gov/utility-billing/questions-about-garbage/> for more information about what is allowed and what is not.

Brush pick up is on a 2 month rotating schedule but you cannot put brush out any earlier than 30 days before your pick up week. Both pick up zones and the 2017 brush pick up schedule are located at <http://inglesidetx.gov/public-works/> under the tree trimming information. Please be considerate when placing your brush and do not create a dangerous site obstruction at an intersection or a neighbor's driveway.

The City of Ingleside Urgent Notification System

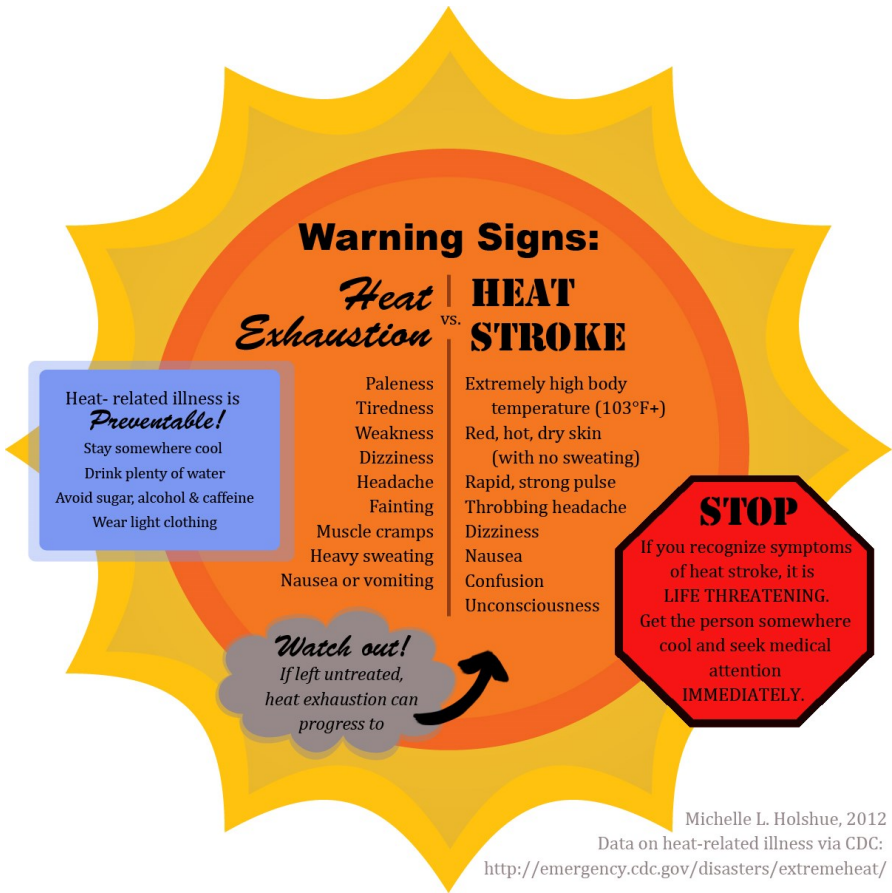
