Building permits are required for storm damage repairs or demolition even through the permit fees for the same have been waived. Also, a WPI-1 is required for the permitting of any kind of structural repairs, to include, but not limited to: windows, doors, siding and roofing. All permit applications can be found on our website at: www.inglesidetx.gov or contact the Building Department at 2665 San Angelo, 361/776-3815. A list of windstorm inspectors is also available at our location. If you have contracted with an individual or a company to do repairs at your home or place of business, that individual or company is required to be registered as a contractor with the City and to secure the proper permits for the work to be done.

Storm debris removal is no longer available. Every property owner is now responsible for the removal of any construction/storm debris. Please contact the Building Department for a price list for the San Patricio County Drop-Off and Citizen Collection Center located at 3141 FM 3512, Aransas Pass, 361/758-5276.

The Bulk Pick Up Program has been reinstated as of February 6, 2018; however, the pickup day has changed to every Tuesday. Please be aware that every property owner who has bulky items must call 361/776-2517 no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday in order to be picked up on Tuesday. The City of Ingleside has resumed scheduled residential brush pick up for current utility customers. The 2018 Brush Route Map and Schedule are available on the City of Ingleside Website: <u>http://inglesidetx.gov.</u> Please cut your brush into 6 foot lengths and stack it so the brush is not under low hanging tree limbs or electrical lines; do not stack in drainage ditches or on top of water or gas meters. 🚵 Bulky Trash Pick Up Returns to Ingleside

Republic Services, the City's garbage contractor, has resumed Bulk Pick Up services. Bulk Pick Up services was previously done on Fridays, but now it will be performed on **TUESDAYS**. You will need to call City Hall at 361-776-2517 on **MONDAY** afternoons before 4:00 p.m. to inform us that you will have Bulk Pick Up items out by the road.

If you fail to inform us, your items will not get picked up. After you inform us, your Bulk Pick Up items must be at the curb on Tuesday by 8:00 a.m. or your items may not get picked up. Place your items so that they are not under low hanging tree limbs or electrical lines; do not stack in drainage ditches or on top of water or gas meters. Bulk Pick Up items consist of stoves, water tanks, washing machines, furniture, and other large items that are too large or too heavy to fit in the trash can. Construction debris, boxes, and bagged items of any kind are NOT considered bulky items and will not get picked up. Please call the Utility Department at 361-776-2517 for more information or questions regarding your garbage services.
